Question

“Will the Chair advise whether any permanent or fixed term contract States employees receive a subsidy, in whole or in part, towards school fees, beyond what is generally available to all Islanders, and, if so, will he detail the number of staff and children who benefit from these subsidies and indicate in which sector the employees work?”

Answer

The States Employment Board can confirm that no States employee has received a subsidy towards school fees, either in whole or in part, beyond what is generally available to all Islanders. Some schools offer means-tested bursaries or support for exceptional circumstances, such as financial hardship.
