REPORT

Following further consultation with the non-ministerial departments I have agreed to bring forward an amendment to the [Draft Public Records \(Jersey\) Amendment Law 202-](#) which would remove paragraph 2B from Article 38(2).

This is a very minor change which will ensure the amended Public Records (Jersey) Law is aligned with the expressions used elsewhere in respect of non-ministerial departments, such as in the [States of Jersey Law 2005](#).

This amendment is therefore clarificatory and does not affect the operation of sub-paragraph 2A before it.

Financial and staffing implications

There are no staffing or resource implications as a result of this amendment.
