Arrangement of Public Business for the Present Meeting

THE STATES noted that, in accordance with Standing Order 34(1), the Chair of the Comité des Connétables had informed the Greffier of the States that the amendment of the Comité to the proposition of the Council of Ministers entitled ‘Proposed Budget (Government Plan) 2026-2029’ (P.70/2025) had been withdrawn.

THE STATES, adopting a proposition of Deputy Montfort Tadier of St. Brelade, agreed, in accordance with Standing Order 80, to suspend Standing Order 32 in order that his amendment (P.70/2025 Amd.(33).Amd.) to his amendment (P.70/2025 Amd.(33) to the proposition of the Council of Ministers entitled ‘Proposed Budget (Government Plan) 2026-2029’ (P.70/2025) might be listed for consideration at the present meeting; and further agreed in accordance with Standing Order 26(7), to reduce

the minimum lodging period in respect of the same proposition in order that it might be debated at the present meeting.
