

APPEALS PROCEDURE UNDER MINISTERIAL GOVERNMENT

Case Considered

A licence holder loses his job after 2 years in the post and therefore is no longer entitled to remain in controlled accommodation.

Stage 1

Employer and/or individual approaches Population Office with request for a period of time to either obtain alternative licence job, or alternative accommodation. Department takes reasonable view in the light of family circumstances eg children schooling, type of job etc and grants period of time (say 6 months).

After 5 months still in accommodation and unable to find alternative job- appeals to the Department for a longer period. Considered by Manager of the Population Office either extension allowed or refused, if refused appeal to the Director, if refused appeal to the Deputy Minister then still refused appeal to the Minister, if refusal maintained applicant has rights of appeal to the Administrative Review Board process or to the Royal Court.

So the line of approach and appeal would be:

Population Office Staff

Population Office Manager

Population Office Director

Deputy Minister

Minister

Review Board or Right to appeal to Royal Court
