Scope of delegation:	Full delegation in line with the requirements of the above legislation. This includes the authority to sign ministerial decisions in respect of these areas. Full delegation to lodge new intellectual property legislation and any amendments to the above existing legislation and to present reports to the States Assembly relating to any matters of Intellectual Property.
