Question

“Will the Minister advise what consultation, if any, has taken place between his officers and the States of Jersey Police (SOJP) to ensure that the new mobile speed camera due to be deployed soon by the SOJP complies with the Island’s highway legislation?”

Answer

Officers from Infrastructure and Environment have engaged closely with the States of Jersey Police (SOJP) throughout the selection, procurement and commissioning of the new mobile speed camera.

Considerations have included compliance and enforcement; and it is considered that the use of independently operated speed cameras does not conflict with existing legal requirements within the Road Traffic (Jersey) Law 1956. The speed camera provides adequate corroboration, and there are not considered to be restrictions on admitting its evidence in court.
