Arm's Length Bodies, Grants and Subsidies Review

Thank you for your attendance at the recent public hearing with the Public Accounts Committee (PAC) as part of its review of Arm's Length Bodies, Grants and Subsidies. Further to the hearing, the PAC would be grateful if you could provide a response to the following questions and request for information:

1. Please can the PAC be provided, in confidence, with the risk registers for each ALB under your remit contained in the Public Finances Manual and how these are linked to the departmental risk register.
2. Can the PAC please be provided with the framework that was used for grant allocations to organisations set out in [WQ-313-2025](#) and can we also request minutes of any decisions taken to award this funding.
3. Please can you provide macro indicators for each organisation under your remit in receipt of grant funding.
4. How are pay awards and uplifts calculated for the grants awarded to the ALB's and organisations under your remit?
5. During the hearing you noted that funding had been held back in reserves as they did not require the full grant amount. Can you please confirm how much has been held back for each organisation in reserves?
6. Please can the PAC be provided in confidence with the Internal Audit report on Visit Jersey noted during the hearing.
7. Please can we be provided with all partnership meeting minutes for the last 12 months that you have held with the organisations under your remit.
8. We note from paragraph 45 of the C&AG report 'Oversight of Arm's Length Bodies' the following point:

'There is a risk however that annual reviews of individual ALOs do not consider sufficiently the opportunities for co-ordination and amalgamation of activities across ALOs. The Economy Department has identified the risk and commenced a more holistic review of four ALOs to consider opportunities for savings.'

Please can you explain the status of this review and if it is intended to be published in due course?

The PAC would be grateful if you could provide a response to these queries by Thursday 30th October 2025. It is the intention of the PAC to publish both this letter and the response on the States Assembly website except where information is provided in confidence.
