Draft Food (Jersey) Regulations 202-

Dear Minister,

I am writing to confirm the Environment, Housing & Infrastructure Panel's intended approach to its scrutiny of the *Draft Food (Jersey) Regulations 202-* ([P.113/2025](#)) (the 'draft Regulations'), which is scheduled for States Assembly earliest debate on 3rd February 2026.

The Panel has considered and discussed the draft Regulations in light of private briefings received on 17th July and 28th November 2025 and intends to undertake targeted scrutiny of specific elements of the draft Regulations.

In terms of the legislative timetable, the Panel intends to proceed with the scheduled States Assembly debate on the principles of the draft Regulations on 3rd February 2026. Subject to the Assembly approving the Regulations in principle, the Panel will then call in the draft Regulations for focused scrutiny on those identified areas.

At this point the Panel intends to seek evidence from a limited number of key stakeholders relevant to the issues under consideration, with detail on the scope and timing of any further work to be confirmed in due course.

The Panel wished to notify you of this intended approach at the earliest opportunity and will provide further updates as the work progresses.
