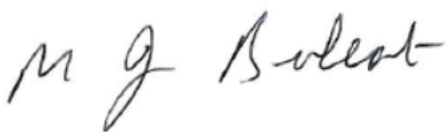

A recent report ([R.143/2026](#)) included a transfer of functions for the Planning and Building (General Development) (Jersey) Order 2011, as well as confirmation of the required amendments to the Royal Court Rules 2004, particularly in relation to the High Hedges (Jersey) Law 2008) and the Schedule 4B notice of appeal under the Planning and Building (Jersey) Law 2002).
