**PFAS – Invitation to a Public Hearing**

Following its most recent meeting, the Environment, Housing & Infrastructure Scrutiny Panel has agreed to convene a stand-alone hearing on 20th March 2026 regarding Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) and requests your attendance.

This hearing will include questioning on the PFAS Scientific Advisory Panel's Fourth Report on PFAS in food, soil, waste and private water supplies, expected to be published on 19th March 2026, including the Government's readiness to implement any of its recommendations, as well as the recently lodged Draft Water Law (Jersey) Amendment Regulations 202- ([P.26/2025](#)).

The Panel hopes this session will give Islanders clear information on the progress the Government intends to make in addressing the challenges posed by PFAS. We will be in touch with arrangement details in due course.
