Quarterly Public Hearing

The Corporate Services Scrutiny Panel (the Panel) wishes to set out the intended purpose of this first quarterly hearing. The hearing will focus on understanding how you have worked with Ministers to identify priorities and developing the forthcoming Common Strategic Policy, together with the outcomes that the Council of Ministers intends to deliver for Islanders during the current term of office. Through this discussion, the Panel hopes to gain a clearer understanding of the Council of Ministers' strategic direction, the long term vision underpinning its priorities, and the measures by which success will be assessed over the course of the term.

The Panel notes that it intends to ask questions regarding the appointment of the new Chief Executive Officer. In order to facilitate a full discussion, there may be occasions during this section of the hearing where the Panel considers it appropriate for the Chief Executive Officer to temporarily leave the hearing while certain matters are discussed.

Further, the Panel would be grateful if you could please provide a copy of the job description for the roles of Chief Executive Officer and Deputy Chief Executive Officer. The Panel would like to know what key performance indicators have been established for the Chief Executive Officer role, and what arrangements are in place for monitoring and assessing performance against those objectives.

The Panel would appreciate to receive a formal written response, including the job descriptions and KPIs by 11 September 2026. Please be aware that it is the Panel's intention to publish the response it receives on the States Assembly website. However, should any of the information provided be confidential, please can you inform the Panel accordingly.
