Fuel Prices

The Panel would like to request an update on the steps currently being taken by your Department, and by the wider Government, to monitor fuel prices in Jersey, recognising the significant impact that fuel costs have on the already high cost of living in the Island.

In particular, the Panel seeks further information on the mechanisms being used to track fuel prices given their effect on household and business costs, as well as details of any contingency planning underway in response to the present geopolitical risks and the associated volatility in global energy markets.

We would be grateful if you could respond no later than Monday 30th March 2026 in line with the 5 working days approved for responses between Scrutiny Panels and Ministers.
