Agenda matter	Action
1. Delivery of the Common Strategic Policy – Ministerial Response The Panel discussed the Ministerial Response to its report ‘Delivery of the Common Strategic Policy’ (S.R.5/2025), which had been presented to the States on 13th January 2026. The Panel noted that the response explained that Ministers were prioritising the final delivery of the government’s programme ahead of the election period. As a result, decisions on the Panel’s recommendations reflected this focus, with scope for the next Council of Ministers to revisit them when developing the new Common Strategic Policy. In this context, it was noted that one recommendation had been accepted, two partially accepted, and eight rejected. The Panel requested that a press notice be drafted expressing its disappointment with the response. It was agreed that the notice should highlight that there were areas across government requiring attention, such as the ageing population, and that it was important for Jersey to see tangible outcomes before the end of the current term. The Officer advised that a Communications Officer would circulate a draft press notice to the Chair in due course.	KB
