

Submission – Draft Road Traffic Law (Drug Limits) Regulations 202- Anonymous 3 – 17th February 2026

I now read that the panel believe you will be OK to drive 6 hours after consuming medical cannabis, so in theory people can still go to work.

However this is incorrect.

I have recently purchased test kits at the proposed limits. In all cases no one had consumed cannabis that day (all has a minimum of 12 hours since last consuming any cannabis, and all had prescriptions).

In one case they hadn't consumed any cannabis for 3 days.

In all cases the individuals failed the test, and so will fail the proposed limits.

In no cases were the people intoxicated, and some of the individuals were professionals who were working! Im not sure how the members of the police force with prescriptions will be able to manage this.

This is why the UK included legislation for driving with medical cannabis which we have omitted, which is negligent in my view.

By part implementing legislation, we are criminalising over 5000 people in the Island, and that's not acceptable.

As such I ask the scrutiny panel to properly consider this matter, which will become a public issue in an election year.
